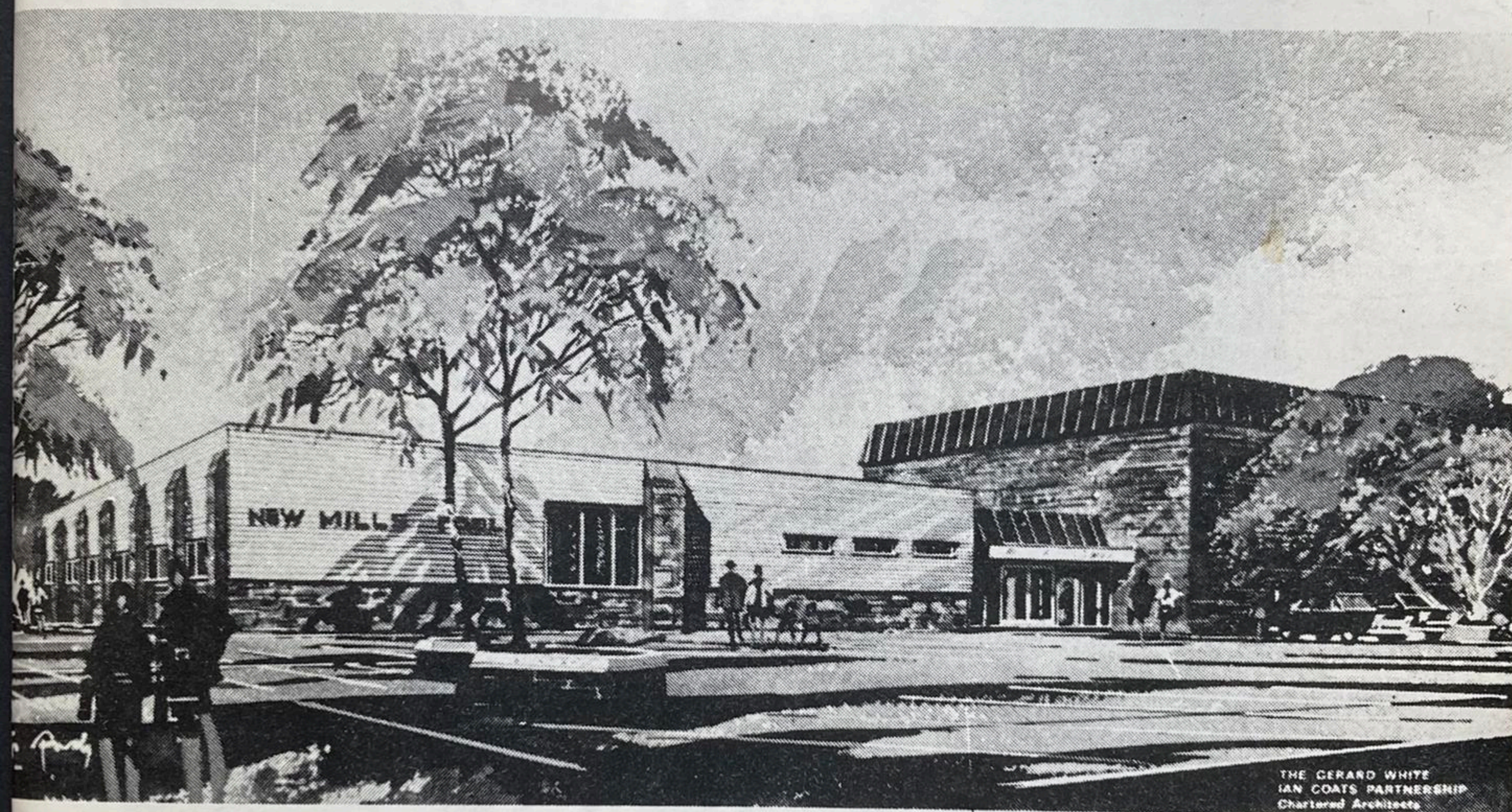

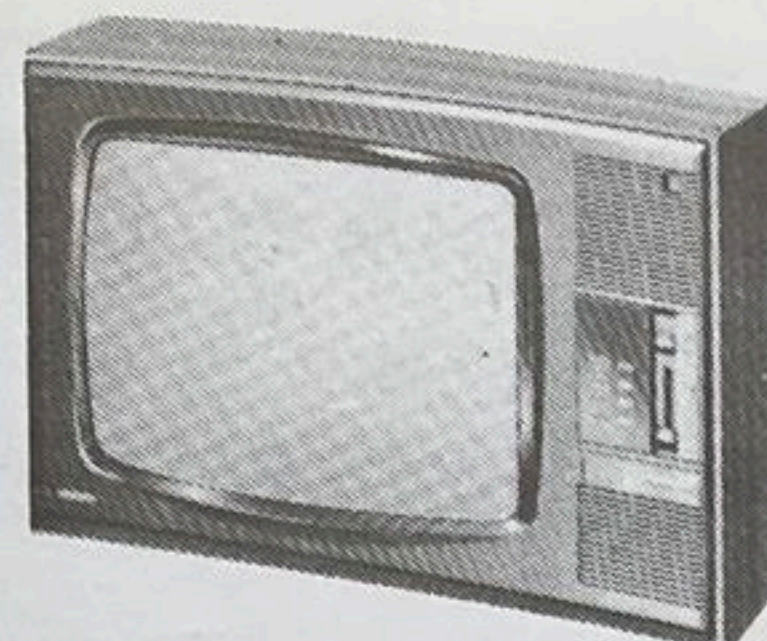

Presidential Address to the NEWSPA Carnival Programme

Carnival time is here. New Mills is extremely fortunate in having a hard working committee whose prime interest is to raise funds for a swimming pool. Many members have been on the committee from the outset, but no matter how long they have worked for the Association they are all dedicated. Although politics do not enter the thoughts of anyone when working for the Association, it is a fact that we have a complete range of interests, and no matter which party is in power, in County, District or Parish, our committee can talk with them all.

Recently I read an optimistic letter from some of the District Councillors, expressing their views prior to any council debates. Subsequently I telephoned the Chairman of the Borough Policy Committee, and he passed on to me some interesting news. Sometime towards the middle of April, The District Council will seriously consider our project, and it is an open secret that the Council does have sufficient funds available to finance a pool without having to go out onto the money market and borrow, thus releasing the project from monetary interest. This would have been a millstone around our necks for the next sixty years. What has to be settled between N.E.W.S.P.A., the Parish and the District Council is, what facilities are going to be provided, i.e., Squash Courts, Gymnasium, Skateboard park etc., and perhaps the most important point of all is, who is going to pay for the upkeep and running costs?

I hope that by the time you read this, many of these questions and doubts will have been satisfactorily overcome, and from a dream of five years, realisation will be fulfilled, and that by this time next year work will have commenced.

When we finally get our pool, I hope that everyone who has given money in the past will not just shrug their shoulders and say, "no more can I do", for what we want is a steady stream of swimmers, being children during school hours, keep fit addicts to 'fight the flab' or just the enjoyment of being able to swim and relieve the tensions of the days.
